

# Notice of work:

## The South Frame

### Kahikatea Common to Durham Street

<b>What</b>	Construction of The Greenway
<b>Where</b>	Between Kahikatea Common and Durham Street South
<b>When</b>	From Monday 3 February for about five months

#### WHAT WE ARE DOING

Citycare, on behalf of Ōtākaro Limited, is constructing The Greenway between Kahikatea Common and Durham Street South. This will complete the section of the South Frame in the block bordered by Montreal, Durham, St Asaph and Tuam Streets.

Work involves installing new lighting, rain gardens and planting along with green screens and street furniture. We will start work at the Kahikatea Common end of our work site, in the existing car park area, then steadily work our way east towards Durham Street.

When completely finished, the South Frame will connect the One Central homes and SALT District in the east to the Health Precinct and Avon River Precinct in the west, forming an entirely new pedestrian and cyclist-friendly route around the central city.

## HOW THIS MAY IMPACT YOU

### *Parking*

The new section of The Greenway extends from Kahikatea Common, through the Land Information New Zealand (LINZ) car park and onwards through to Durham Street South. Because of this, some existing car parks will become unavailable in the LINZ car park:

Numbers 15 – 20 (west side)

Numbers 49 – 57 (east side).

Because we will fence our entire work area, there will be no thoroughfare across the new section of The Greenway. Car parks on the southern side of The Greenway will need to be accessed from St Asaph Street, and car parks on the northern side from Tuam Street.

## TRAFFIC IMPACTS

We will enter and exit our work site from Durham Street South.
