

# WHAT ARE WE DOING?

We're completely digging out the existing intersection, building new structural asphalt sublayers and laying the final surface layer, weather depending.

Normally we would rebuild the intersection one corner, or 'quadrant', at a time. Completing them all over one weekend will speed up our works – shortening our timeframe for completion by up to four weeks.

Intersection rebuild works start at 8pm on Friday 18 May 2018 and will be complete by 6am Monday 21 May 2018.

# **HOW THIS WORK MAY IMPACT YOU**

Manchester Street will be closed to all traffic between Cambridge Terrace and Gloucester Street. Armagh Street will remain closed between Madras Street and Manchester Street. Detour routes will be in place — please follow all signage and instructions from site staff.

Armagh Street, between Colombo and Manchester Streets, will be made temporarily two-way to provide access to local businesses and car parks. A safe turning area will be created at the Manchester Street end of the street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
