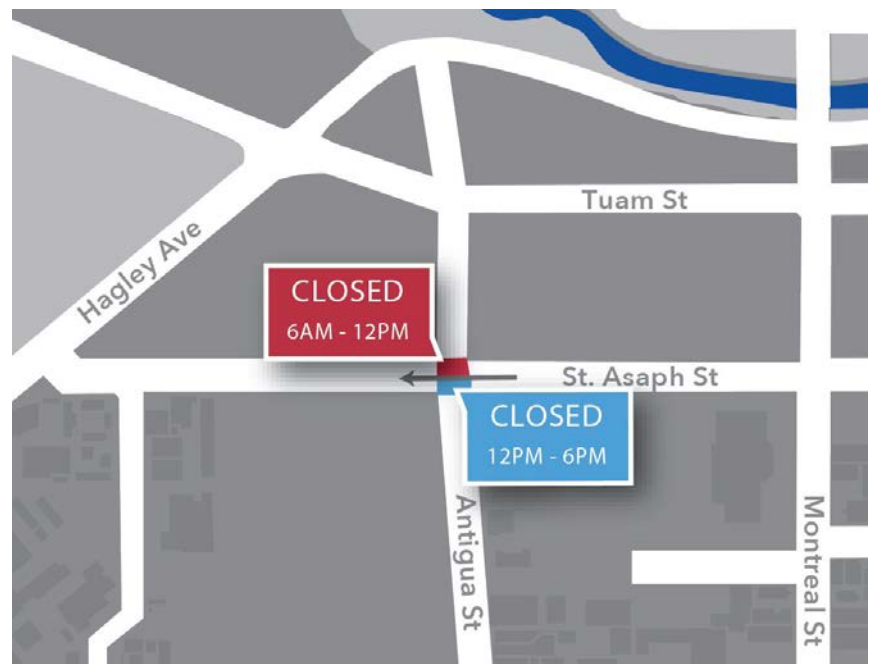

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Having rebuilt this intersection earlier in the year we are returning to finish the road surface.

TRAFFIC

- We will work on the intersection in two halves, maintaining one lane of traffic flow on St Asaph Street at all times.
- Traffic will not be able to travel north or south through the intersection. Access is for businesses only. No through route.
- Buses will be detoured during some of the works.

WHY IS THIS WORK HAPPENING?

Work on St Asaph Street is well underway to create a direct and efficient, two lane, pedestrian and cycle friendly, east-to-west route through the central city for all forms of transport. This will support the effective functioning of the Christchurch Hospital and the new Outpatients building. Overhead power lines have been removed from St Asaph Street and it will have a modern, open feel, leading to the beautiful and iconic Hagley Park on its western edge.

HOW THIS WORK MAY IMPACT YOU

The current single lane access east-west along St Asaph Street will be maintained through these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained around the junction and access to businesses and buildings on St Asaph and Antigua Street should be unaffected. Some localised and temporary coned off zones may be necessary to permit access to areas. There will be increased levels of localised noise, dust and vibration for short periods for which we apologise.

The St Asaph Street work is expected to finish by the end of July 2018 and the entire Hospital Corner work will be complete by the end of 2018.
