## Te Papa Ōtākaro/Avon River Precinct

### Oxford Terrace

**What** Early morning concrete pour

**Where** Oxford Terrace, between Montreal Street and the Pegasus Arms

**When** Monday 28 May, from 4am until 7am

**Why** Because of the narrow nature of this site it is easiest to carry out these works outside of business hours to minimise disruption to the general public

### WHAT ARE WE DOING?

On **Monday 28 May** we will pour concrete on Oxford Terrace between Montreal Street and the Pegasus Arms. Works will start at 4am, with the first concrete truck arriving just before 5am. Works will finish around 7am.

Works are subject to weather—should it be very cold or wet the works will be postponed.

### HOW THIS MAY IMPACT YOU

There will be some noise, but we expect it to be no louder than the recent Montreal/Tuam intersection works. It is easiest to carry out this work in the early morning to avoid disruption to the general public.
