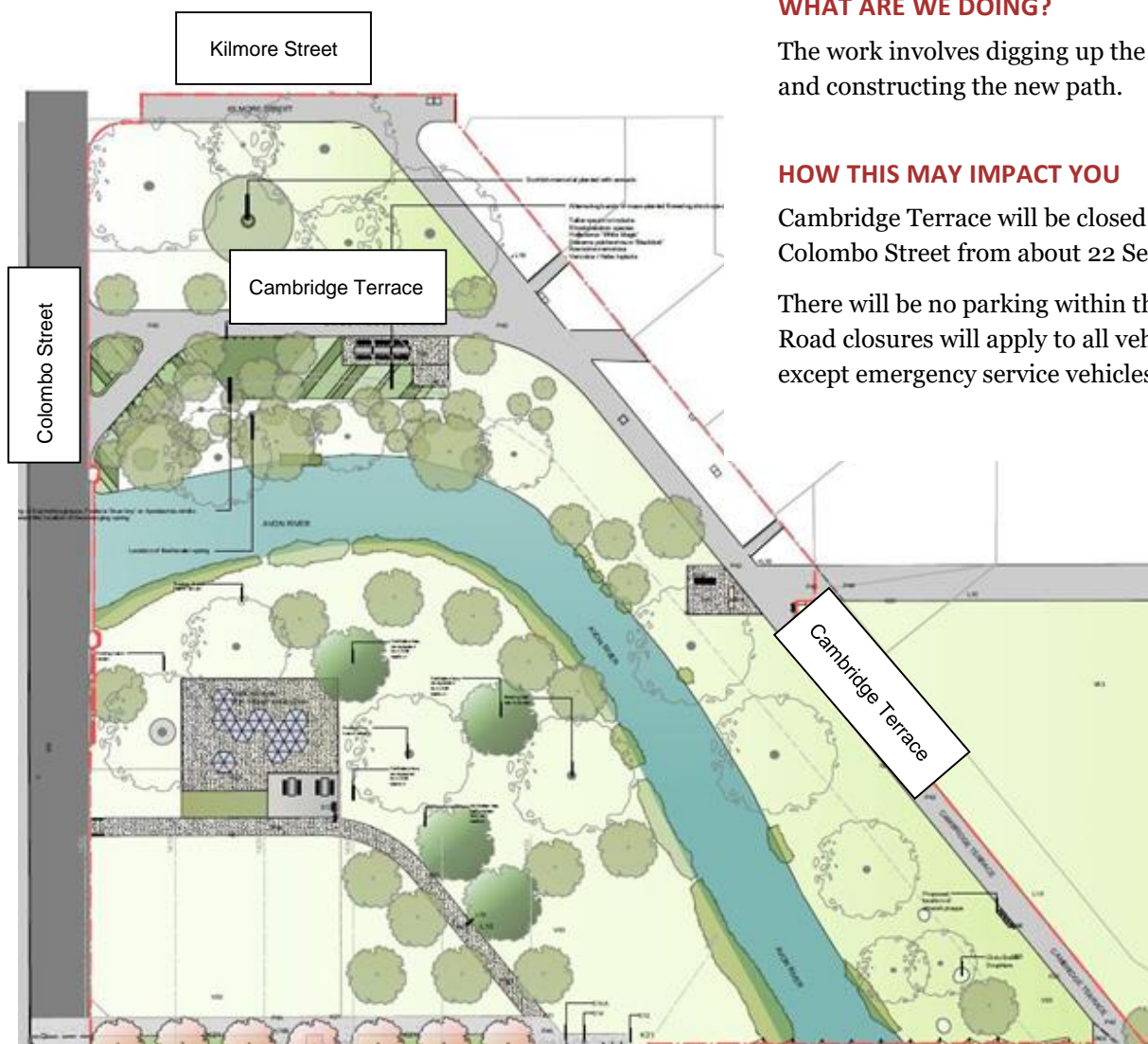


Notice of work: North Frame Shared Path – Cambridge Terrace

- What** Cambridge Terrace east of Colombo Street is being transformed into a shared path.
- Where** The path will extend from Colombo Street to connect with the new shared path that has been constructed along Cambridge Terrace from Manchester Street.
- When** The road will be closed on 22 September 2017. Work will start around 2 October and will be complete by mid-2018.
- Why** The shared path on the north side of the Ōtākaro Avon River, connecting Colombo Street with Manchester Street, is a key feature of the North Frame.



WHAT ARE WE DOING?

The work involves digging up the existing road, and constructing the new path.

HOW THIS MAY IMPACT YOU

Cambridge Terrace will be closed to traffic at Colombo Street from about 22 September 2017. There will be no parking within the work areas. Road closures will apply to all vehicle traffic except emergency service vehicles.

ADDITIONAL IMPACTS

Pedestrian access around this area will be maintained throughout the construction, although not all footpaths will always be open.

There will be construction noise while this work is being carried out.
